Member Credit Process

Intro

Surf Life Saving SA recognises that members, outside of the VET in Schools programme, wish to obtain the PUA30322 Certificate III in Public Safety (Aquatic Search & Rescue) in recognition for the training they have completed within Surf Life Saving.

The SLSSA Certificate III in Public Safety (Aquatic Search and Rescue) PUA30322 is recognised on the SACE VET Recognition Register should it be needed for any Year12s.

SLSSA uses the units of competency aligned to various SLS awards in order to gain the credit towards their Certificate III.

Pathways into the Certificate III in Public Safety (Aquatic Search and Rescue) PUA30322 qualification

Candidates may enter the qualification after achieving the PUA20119 Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue), obtained in the Bronze Medallion.

How many SACE points and nominal hours is associated to PUA30322?

The standard VETIS programme delivered by SLSSA, participants can expect to achieve 30 SACE points on completion of PUA30322 or 280 nominal hours.

Fee

The fees attached to each award will vary but the admin fee for processing the Certificate III in Public Safety (Aquatic Search and Rescue) PUA30322 is \$150.
