

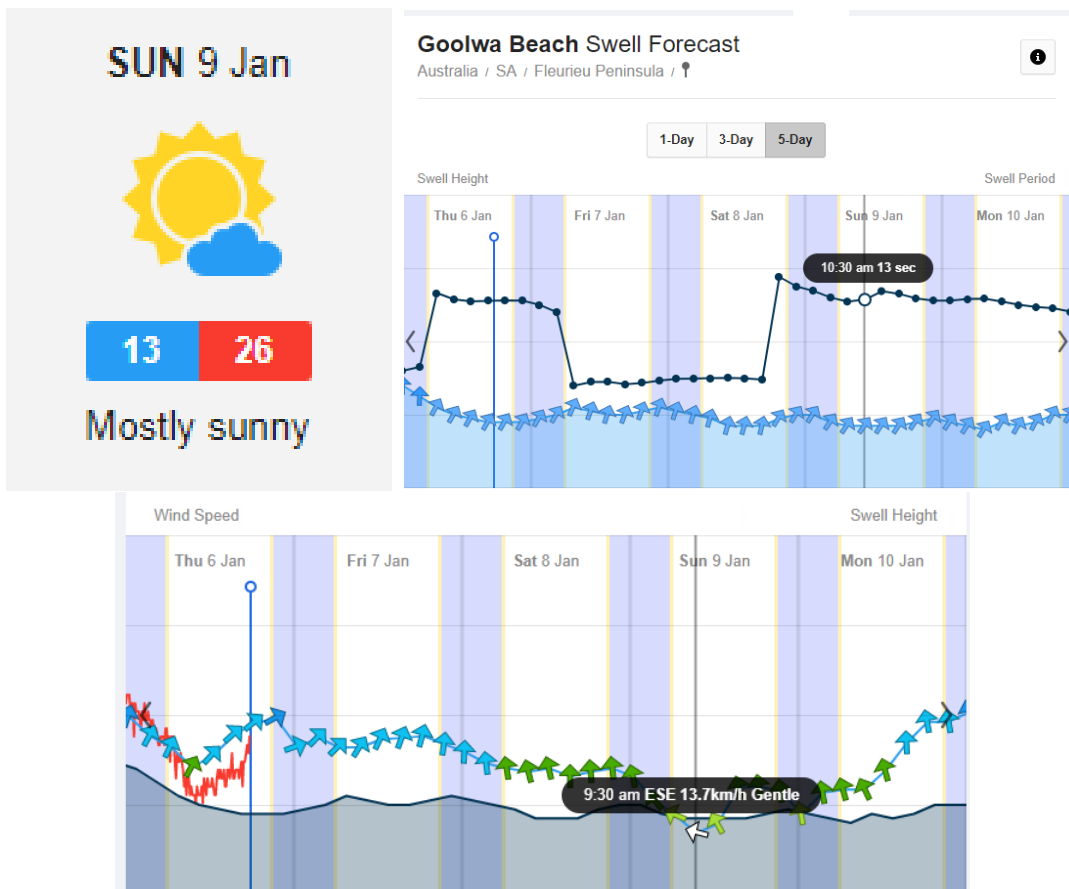

BEACH VEHICLE ACCESS

Any vehicles towing surf boats are to be suitable 4WDs with competent drivers. ALL vehicles & trailers are to be parked on the eastern side of the access ramp, NOT in boat area. Please drive safely & adhere to the speed limits – there has been a lot of vehicle incidents on Goolwa beach recently.

If assistance is required to get surf boat trailers onto the beach, please park the trailer in the car park indicated on the site map.

COVID

Please do not attend the event if,

- Unwell with symptoms
- You are confirmed positive case
- You are a close contact in quarantine period
- You are still awaiting a test result

All attendees need to check in on arrival, QR codes & paper check will be available at the top of the stairs. A separate QR code will be available at the Surf Boat Area.

Sanitiser will be available & masks are encouraged to be worn where social distancing is not possible.

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TEAM CHANGES

WARM UP

Warmups at the start of the day should not occur until water safety are in position and the carnival committee with PA announcement confirms it is safe to enter for warmups. Priority for warm up initially will be skis (blue area) & youth boards (pink area) once deemed available to do so.
