This Carnival is yet to receive an SA Health approved COVID Management Plan (it has been submitted & awaiting response). Assuming that this approval is given and COVID restrictions allow for the event to proceed, there are a number of aspects of compliance that MUST be followed otherwise we risk a fine and the non-approval of any further carnivals as per previous carnivals. If this approval is NOT granted, we may need to enforce restrictions on numbers & potential amendments to the program to ensure the event falls within the maximum 1000 person limit. Updates re event status will be provided to Clubs as soon as available.

COMPOSITE TEAMS

- Are only permitted for Clubs which cannot fill their FIRST team in any event
- Clubs who are eligible are required to label such teams in SEMS as 'composite' for easy identification
- Will be pre-allocated by random draw after close of entries & notified to the relevant clubs so they can liaise with the other Club/s involved
- The priority will be to form the team from the composites available (ie smaller clubs) & only if insufficient will then draw on any non-assigned event competitors from larger Clubs who have 'surplus' competitors. This will be done in a designated order of clubs for each event therefore allowing Clubs (who potentially have children who may have missed out on making one of the Club's teams) to have fair opportunity for a call up for involvement in a composite team in addition to their full teams



DIVISIONAL RACING

As supported and subsequently endorsed by the Surf Sports Advisory Committee, most Junior Surf Sports events will be conducted in divisions for 2021-22 to provide more opportunity for competition at the ability of each participant.

- Individual Events = division 1, 2 & 3 for each female and male category per age group
- Team Events = division 1 & 2 for each age group

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via **SEMS** (find 2022 SA Junior State Championships)

Entry Fees

The event entry fee is set at \$45 (+ GST) per entered competitor. Please note that the entry fee covers ALL of the state championship events for Under 8 – Under 13s.

Any late entry (ie received after 10am, Wednesday prior to each weekend and before 6pm on Friday immediately prior to the weekend's events) will be charged at \$90 (+ GST) per late entry competitor.

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the championships. Clubs can advise of any entered members who are unable to participate as a result of COVID impacts to remove their entry from the invoicing list.

Eligibility

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries (Tuesday 16 March 2021).

If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there is a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency. Please contact us if you have any queries re this.



INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

Detailed information for Clubs to distribute to families will be forwarded ASAP (we are awaiting SA Health ruling re COVID Management Plan which will dictate our permissible spectator numbers), however, the following key points should be communicated:

- Do NOT attend if unwell
- Follow and comply with SA Health rules, restrictions and guidelines as per https://www.covid-19.sa.gov.au/ and school settings
- Please limit the number of spectators/supporters per family. Depending on outcome of COVID Management Plan, this may need to be capped per competitor (may include or exclude designated volunteers).
- All attending persons need will need to complete a registration process (link to be forwarded prior to each weekend)
- Any person/s found to be non-compliant with our COVID requirements will be asked to leave. If needed, SAPOL assistance will be sought.

WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there be a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.



CLUB & VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

The Junior State Championships Officials & Volunteer Roster is to be completed by Clubs by 12noon on the Thursday prior to each weekend. The following roles are to be filled by Clubs & details provided in the above Roster.

- Roster for 19-20 March link will be emailed ASAP

As there is a 100 person limit & to ensure volunteers are only meeting relevant for their role, we will use the following timetable for the briefing:

- 7.30pm 8pm = Carnival Committee, Leadership Team, All officials, Team Managers
- 8pm-8.30pm = Age Managers & Team Managers
- 8.30pm-8.50pm = Water Safety, Club Photographers, IRB crews, Work Party, COVID Marshals, Team Managers

1. Team Manager - max. 1 per Club per day

2. Age Managers

- a. MAXIMUM 2 per age group (best practice should be 1 x male & 1 x female)
- b. Should wear Club identifiable clothing or lanyard + sun safe hat
- c. Should be familiar with the competitor/team lists for their age group
- d. Will liaise with Area Referees, Marshals re competition matters
- e. Are to attend (as many as possible) the Pre-Carnival BRIEFING on Thurs 10 March (& Thur 17 March for Moana weekend), <u>8pm-8.40pm</u> via Zoom https://us02web.zoom.us/j/4604908086

3. Event Assistants (will collectively help with the running of the events)

- a. Additional helpers from Clubs with 10+ participants per age group (max 1 per 5 participants from 11+)
- b. Will work as a collective team to assist ALL CLUBS' PARTICIPANTS as needed with tasks such as lining up participants for events, managing behaviour whilst awaiting races, helping ensure children are sun & COVID safe, moving equipment (including board handling for board relay/iron)
- c. Help ensure the area provides safe, fair & inclusive sport for ALL age group participants
- d. Model & promote good sideline behaviour
- e. Will be provided with a fluoro yellow vest (wear over other clothing) to identify as event helper
- f. Please wear a sun safe hat.

4. Officials

- a. Officials allocations are a combination of dedicated to each area + 4 x officials who will move from event to event with each age group (they will be course/finish line judges + course statistics in water events). Please refer to roster
- b. Some roles have been pre-allocated to specific officials based on their previously indicated availability
- c. Are to wear comfortable, sun safe clothing (non-Club branded). Coloured vests are provided on the day for those allocated to a particular area & white vests for those who are allocated to age groups

5. Water Safety Personnel

- a. Club requirement as per above roster
- b. Must be proficient SRC or BM members (no more than 50% can be SRC only)
- c. Are to wear SURF RESCUE uniform & have rescue board or tube with them



d. Allocated to specific water area/s according to the volunteer roster

- e. All water safety personnel will be pre-allocated in the SLS Patrol Ops App only those whose name appears will be signed on (or their substitute) & permitted in the field of play.
- f. Are to attend (as many as possible) the Pre-Carnival BRIEFING on Thurs 10 March (& Thur 17 March for Moana weekend), **8.30pm-8.50pm** via Zoom https://us02web.zoom.us/i/4604908086

6. IRB Water Cover

- a. The rostered clubs (refer Circular) for this event are:
 - a. Saturday 12 March = Glenelg x 2 + Somerton
 - b. Sunday 13 March = Glenelg + Henley + West Beach
 - c. Saturday 19 March = Moana x 2 + South Port + Grange (incl senior areas)
 - d. Sunday 20 March = Moana x 2 + Brighton (incl senior areas)
- b. SLSSA will make payment of \$220+gst per IRB to the relevant club/s after the event
- c. Drivers/crew to attend (as many as possible) the Pre-Carnival BRIEFING

7. Shallow Water Rescue personnel

- a. Competent, skilled surf swimmer (1 x BM proficient per rostered Club) who would be called upon to assist should a shallow water rescue occur.
- b. Such persons will be called for a briefing at start of their session.
- c. They are not required to wear patrol uniform but should have bathers etc under clothing should they be required to act.

8. Photographer/s

- a. Maximum <u>3</u> photographers per club at any one time during the carnival with max. 1 per any individual competition area
- b. Must be registered members + have a Working with Children (DCSI/DHS) Check RECORDED on SURFGUARD
- c. Must be listed on the Volunteer Roster by 12noon, Thurs 18 March
- d. Are to attend (as many as possible) the Pre-Carnival BRIEFING

9. Work Party & COVID Marshals

- a. 12-13 March = allocated Clubs are to have 1 x person available on call during the day should work party be required. This shouldn't mean more than 20-30mins work over the weekend.
- b. SA Health require the presence of 14 x COVID Marshals for the entirety of the event Clubs are to provide volunteers (who are to have completed the COVID Marshal Training Certificate) as per the roster
- c. Are to attend (as many as possible) the Pre-Carnival BRIEFING

The final carnival information will include details re timetabling, logistics, weather forecast & site map.
