<b>Summary:</b>	The 2022 Surf Life Saving SA Pool Rescue season will be conducted from May to July 2022. This circular provides information and guidelines regarding the various aspects of the competition.

- **Sat 2 July (PM only): U15-Open Individual Events only** - 200m Super Lifesaver, 100m Rescue Medley, 100m Manikin Carry with Fins, 50m Manikin Carry.  
*Extra events may be added subject to entries received for the championships*
- **Sun 3 July:** All team events & all other Individual events not conducted on Day 1.

\*Depending on number entries for the whole carnival entries for these events may be restricted to those who have completed an expression of interest in state team selection.

Note: U11 Brick Carry competitors can wear fins for these events this season.

## Officials & Volunteers

We do require a small number of officials & volunteers for these carnivals. Clubs for the 1<sup>st</sup> carnival will be rostered to undertake these duties with allocations based on 2020-21 pool rescue participation numbers to be reviewed throughout the season. Please refer to [2022 Pool Rescue Officials & Volunteer Roster](#) for appointments & allocations.

## Photographers

Clubs can have a maximum of 1 x approved media personnel taking photographs at any one time during the carnival (max 1 on pool deck). There is no maximum number of media personnel which a club can list, rather than such persons are identified to SLSSA as filling that role and SLSSA confirms their eligibility (registered member + WWCC recorded on Surfguard).

## Pool Setters/Work Party

Clubs for the 1<sup>st</sup> carnival are rostered to undertake pool setting / work party duties with allocations based on 2020-21 pool rescue participation numbers to be reviewed throughout the season. **These volunteers are expected to assist with moving equipment in the water and should dress appropriately to enter the water (bathers, goggles etc.) and have some level of fitness. (Swim flippers can be worn)**

## Time Keepers

Clubs are rostered to undertake time keeping duties with allocations based on 2020-21 pool rescue participation numbers. **These do not have to be accredited officials.**

## ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

### How to enter competitors

### Entry Fees

The carnival entry fee, as for all SLSSA non-championship carnivals, is set at **\$7.00 per competitor, \$2 Per Spectator**. These fees are to be paid online via the SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre's website before arrival. A link will be provided on the SLSSA calendar event page once ready. **All SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre Memberships holders attending the carnivals are still required to pay competitor and spectator's fees via the SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre's website.**

### Eligibility

<b>SLSC Membership</b>	Registered in SurfGuard for 2021/22. Members are only eligible to compete for the Club with which their Competitive Rights are held
<b>Award/s</b>	U11 competitors = Be the holder of the U11 competition skills evaluation award U12 competitors = Be the holder of the U12 competition skills evaluation award U13 competitors = Be the holder of the U13 competition skills evaluation award U14 & U15 competitors = Be the holder of a proficient <sup>1</sup> Surf Rescue Certificate (or Bronze Medallion) U17, U19 & Open competitors = Be the holder of a proficient <sup>1</sup> Bronze Medallion  New Members- gained or is gaining the required award/s in 2021-22 = Hold 'Award for non-award holders' <sup>2</sup> as a minimum &/or be the holder of a bronze medallion <sup>1</sup>
<b>Patrol Hours</b>	No minimum patrol hour requirement applies for non-championship carnivals.
<b>Other</b>	Must not be in default with their Club or SLSSA in relation to their service, financial or discipline obligations

<sup>1</sup> Proficient is defined as the award expiry date being later than the date of close of entries for the relevant event

<sup>2</sup> For Under 14 age category members this is the Junior Activities Competition Evaluation – Under 14. Other criteria apply (refer Use of SLSSA Equipment Policy 1.02)

**If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there is a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency.** Please contact us if you have any queries re this.

### Line Throw & Patient Tow Teams

Each competitor can only enter one age group/event unless approved to be patient in another race or age group for someone else not to miss out.

## LOGISTICS

### Pool Deck Access

**Spectators will NOT be allowed on pool deck.** Only Officials, Competitors, Volunteers, Team Managers & Coaches are permitted

### Car Parking

Car parking is available in the car park at the front and in the multi-story carpark.

### Food & Drink

SA Aquatic & Leisure do have Café facilities locations and opening times to be advised prior to each carnival via the SLSSA event calendar page.
