State Champs Program: Proposed events to be conducted on Sat 2 July are **highlighted**. Extra events may be added subject to entries received.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

NOTE: in line with Australian Pool Rescue Championships and due to time constraints competitors must compete in their specific age category ONLY and are not eligible to compete in any other age individual events except instances where their age group is not offered in an event (ie masters competitors are able to contest Open Super Lifesaver, Rescue Medley).

To provide a higher quality racing opportunity for competitors and program efficiency we are planning to have all competitors entered into their respective age groups, however on race day they will all swim in the one combined event, with points & medals being split into the respective age groups as we previously done at 2019 & 2021 State Pool Rescue Championships.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via [SEMS](#) by no later than 10am on Tuesday 28 June 2022 (late entries close 10am, Wed 29 June). A guide to entering entries via SEMS can be found [here on our website](#)

If you require SEMS access for another Club officer/s tasked with entering competitors for this event; please log a ticket at support.sls.com.au

As we have to transfer all of our nominations to the appropriate IT program for use at the pool,

PLEASE ONLY ENTER PEOPLE INTO EVENTS THAT THEY WILL COMPETE IN.

This is also critical as competitors will be allocated a lane and 'no shows' can cause **considerable inconvenience**.

If requesting a composite team, please adjust team name to **composite** in SEMS. Composite teams will be pre-drawn prior to the championships.

SLSSA policy allows for Under 15 competitors WITH a proficient Bronze Medallion to compete up in U17, Open or U17-Open TEAM EVENTS only whilst still adhering to maximum of two age groups for any one team event.

Entry Fees

The event entry fee is set at **\$45 (+ GST) per entered competitor**.

Late entry fees are charged for any entries made after 10am on Tuesday 28/6/22 and before close of late entries (5pm, Wednesday 29 June 2022). This fee is set at the entry fee + 100% of entry fee (ie total \$90 + GST).

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the championships.

² Members are only eligible to compete for the Club with which their Competitive Rights are held

*Reserve active members = 8 hours; Clubs may recognise alternative voluntary service hours & if so, maximum 50% of the minimum required hours can be endorsed as service hours (requires formal endorsement by SLSC Club Board and subsequent advice to SLSSA). Life members & long service members are exempt from patrol hour obligations related to championships entry eligibility.

OFFICIALS & VOLUNTEERS

To be eligible to compete, each competing club will be required to provide officials and volunteers **for the ENTIRETY of the event** unless stated. Official & Volunteers allocations can be found on [Volunteer Roster & Club details](#) document. Roles will be assigned and distributed with final event information. **The following roles do not require an accredited official:**

- Equipment setters
- Timekeepers

Timekeeper allocations will be finalised once entries have closed however clubs should be prepared to be allocated at the approx ratios mentioned in table below. Half day rostering may be considered and some roles on the Sunday are only required for the line throw at the start of the day.

EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS

- SLSSA will supply the Rescue Tubes, Manikins, Bricks and Lines for the use of competitors during competition. Such equipment will comply with the ILS/SLSA specifications.
- All competitors are required to supply their own fins (for specifications for compliance please refer SLSA Surf Sports Manual):
 - Rubber fins for U12/13 athletes
 - Fibreglass or Rubber fins for U14 – masters athletes
- All competition equipment may be subject to scrutineering checks during the event
- **Club caps (or swim caps) must be worn and all must be consistent in team events (excluding composite teams).**

MARSHALLING OF EVENTS

Due to the timing system used it is critical that competitors marshal correctly and on time.

All clubs must remind their competitors of the following requirements:

- Marshalling will be called over the PA system
- Competitors must move to the Marshalling room below the grandstand.
- Competitors must have their name checked off and they will then be allocated a lane
- Competitors must **remain in the marshaling room and in this allocated lane** and take the appropriate seat.
- Again, once marched onto pool deck they must stay in lane allocated order

POOL DECK ACCESS

Spectators will NOT be allowed on pool deck. Only Officials, Competitors, Volunteers, Team Managers & Coaches are permitted.

FIRST AID & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre staff will be responsible for any emergency management or first aid required to attendees.

Final Information including logistics will be sent out prior to the pre-event zoom.
