### Introduction

SLSA have created a new award called the Silver Medallion Patrol Captain that replaces the SM Beach Management award. The new award aims to equip you with the skills and knowledge required to confidently manage a beach and a patrol as a Surf Life Saving Patrol Captain. SLSSA will be delivering courses during the off-season, with attendance at both days essential.

## **Course Information**

Course dates are currently being confirmed with the Education and Training team with the goal for courses to run before the commencement of the 23/24 season.

The on the job third party report must be completed prior to the course commencement. This document has been sent out along side this Circular and your Chief Instructors will have a copy of this report.

## **Surf Life Saving entry requirements**

- Minimum 18 years old
- Hold a SLSA Bronze Medallion or have held a SLSA Bronze Medallion and currently hold a patrolling award.
- Have 2 years patrolling experience.

## Pre-requisites before attending the face to face training

- 1. Completed your eLearning and including online assessments
- 2. Completed and saved the leadership workbook found within eLearning
- 3. Downloaded the Operations app. and have access to the Surf Risk Rating (note -this can take up to a week to work properly)
- 4. Complete the On-the Job component. This form must be completed during the patrolling season prior to the course commencement.

#### **Course structure**

- 1. eLearning component (6-8 hours) including online assessments.
- 2. On the Job component This may be signed off by an active Patrol Captain.
- 3. Face to face training occurs over 2 full days. Day one is theory and day 2 is practical scenarios.

## **Learning Outcomes**

By the end of this course participants should be able to:

- Know the role and responsibilities of a Patrol Captain
- Know how to find and when to refer to organisational documents and policies.
- Access and record information relevant to your Patrol
- Apply the principals of effective leadership to motivate and engage team members
- Apply leadership techniques to manage multiple incidents as a Patrol Captain
- Effectively communicate in difficult situations, including managing inappropriate public behaviour
- Complete a Surf Risk Assessment using Surf Risk Rating in the Operations App.
- Lead patrol set up, pack down and manage the beach
- Know how to set up the beach in special circumstances
- Action operational risk and hazard management
- Effectively manage a Patrol Team including the delegation of operational tasks
- Conduct effective briefing and de-briefing, including follow-up
- Coordinate the response to minor and major incidents including working with multi-agencies
