Enduro Gold

Competitors who contest all individual events their respective age will be in contention to win the Enduro Gold.

- U12-U15 Swim & Board
- U17 & Open Swim, Board, Ski

Gold, Silver & Bronze medals will be determined by accumulated points across all the events on the day for each individual event. Points will be scored 20, 19, 18 etc. for each individual event.

In the event of a tie in points accumulated the tie break event (Swim, Board, Ski) will be drawn at the team managers meeting on the morning of the competition.

Masters Enduro

Competitors can contest this as either teams of 2 or 3 or even as individuals. They nominate one competitor to each of the full distance (10.5km Ski, 4km Board, 2km Swim) individual events to contest the Masters Enduro.

Placings will be determined will be determined by accumulated points across the nominated competitors in the enduro teams event across Swim, Board & Ski.

In the event of a tie in points accumulated the tie break event (Swim, Board, Ski) will be drawn at the team managers meeting on the morning of the competition.

Medals

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Medals will be awarded for all individual disciplines (by age/gender category)
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Medals will be awarded for all surf boat events (by age/gender category)
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Medals will be awarded for the Enduro Gold; U12-U15, U17 & Open
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Medals will be awarded for the Masters Enduro

RULES & RACE REQUIREMENTS

Surf Boat events

- Must wear Club competition cap & hi-vis vest (fluoro yellow or pink)
- Each crew must carry a mobile phone on board in case of emergency (ie in waterproof bag/case)
- Leading crews have right of way at bridges; slower crews must give way to faster crews
- All crews must remain on the bow side of the lake & must be vigilant of all other lake users
- Surf boats will start from the boat ramp and finish once the boat has passed the south end of the pontoon
- Surf boats will need to return to the beach area near the start immediately after the race for reloading onto trailers in a timely/orderly manner

Swim, Board & Ski events

- Must wear competition cap (can be SLSC swim cap) & hi-vis vest (fluoro yellow or pink)
- Wetsuit can be worn (max. 5.5mm thickness as per SLSA Surf Sports Manual)
- All competitors must be vigilant of all other lake users
- Events will start in waves
- Start and finish will be on the southern edge of the pontoon
- Ski Course around the rowing course + Island.

WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

If, at any stage prior to or during competition, there is a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

Shallow Water Rescue

As part of the emergency management, a shallow water response team will be gathered if the need arises. The team will comprise **SKILLED SWIMMERS** and clubs are required to nominate such persons (competitors, coaches, officials, other members) when completing the Team Manager information & declaration.



ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

How to enter competitors

individual Entries must be submitted via LiveHeats (find 2023 SA Kozii Enduro)

Individuals can enter & make payment themselves or the club can register & payment for individuals on their behalf.

Note: All events will show \$25 to start with however once you select the first event the other events will change to \$0.

Team Entries (Surf Boats & Enduro Teams) must be submitted via SEMS (find 2023 SA Kozii Enduro)

Team Manager Information & Declaration

Clubs are to complete the <u>Officials & Volunteer Roster</u> (with name of Team Manager & any IRB/First Aid volunteers available by **10am on Monday 16th October 2023**.

Entry Fees

individual event entry fee is set at \$25 (GST inclusive) per entered competitor Note: Payment will be request at the time of registration.

Surf Boat event entry \$75 (GST inclusive) per boat crew. Clubs will be invoiced for all Surf Boat entries following the event.

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries.

¹For Under 15 age category members, the award required is Surf Rescue Certificate and/or Bronze Medallion; Proficient is defined as the award expiry date being later than the date of close of entries for the relevant event; NOTE: for Under 14 age group members, the minimum award for these carnivals is a proficient Junior Activities Under 13 Competition Skills Evaluation from last season or Under 14 Competition Skills Evaluation this season if only joined in 21-22 (MUST have 1:5 water safety provision if not SRC qualified)

If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there is a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency. SEMS will identify the reason when hovering over the 'No' re eligibility.

² Members are only eligible to compete for the Club with which their Competitive Rights are held

³ For Under 16/17 age category and new members the basic assessment is the 400m pool swim (to be completed in <9minutes); for Under 15 age category members this is the 200m swim (to be completed in <5minutes). Other criteria apply (refer Use of SLSA Equipment Policy 1.02)

1. Team Managers

a. Please list names of the relevant Team Managers (senior, junior) – they will be required to attend any relevant briefings

2. Officials

a. Allocations will be posted after the close of entries via the Officials & Volunteer Roster.

3. IRB Water Cover & Emergency management

- a. IRB Water Cover- To provide competent crew capable of setting cans with fully equipped IRB (incl radio)
 - i. 1x Semaphore
 - ii. 1x Grange
 - iii. 1x Brighton
 - iv. 1x Seacliff
- SLSSA will make payment of \$240+gst per IRB to the relevant club/s after the event
- b. First Aid = 2x Glenelg, 2x West Beach (please indicate on the <u>Officials & Volunteer Roster</u> who these people are)

4. U12/13 Water Cover

Clubs are to provide water safety for their Under 12 and Under 13 competitors on a ratio of 1:10. Such water safety shall be provided by registered, proficient Bronze/SRC holders with a rescue or Malibu board. Water safety personnel shall comply with the <u>SLSA Water Safety procedure</u> re uniform (ie patrol shirt or orange water safety rashie)

5. Work Party

Participating Clubs will be required to provide work party volunteers for either set up or pack up based on entries from 2022 enduro = 2x Glenelg, 2x Brighton (please indicate on the Officials & Volunteer Roster who these people are)

6. Photographer/s

- a. Please indicate name of Club Photographer/s on the Club team management list.
- b. Maximum 2 x photographers per Club
- c. Photographers MUST be registered members + have a Working with Children (WWCC) Check & National Police Check (NPC) **RECORDED on SURFGUARD**

LOGISTICS

Tents

Clubs are welcome to BYO tent – these can be placed on the grassed area as indicated on the site map

- a) Must **NOT** be pegged into the ground due to the irrigation system underneath the grassed areas.
- b) Please bring appropriate weighing down items to ensure tents are secured.
