These participants will be ready to become Patrol Captains, and future Club Captains and Duty Officers. It is an ideal opportunity for those who are looking to push their lifesaving skills and build a knowledge of emergency operations. This will be an equally challenging and rewarding week. Camp activities & expected outcomes

- Be trained and assessed for the following awards (or proficiency/update for those already holding the award)
 - Silver Medallion Aquatic Rescue
 - Pool Lifeguard certificate
 - Advanced Resuscitation Techniques
 - PUA30319 – Certificate III in Public Safety (Aquatic Search and Rescue)
- Undertake lifesaving and emergency operations scenarios and challenges
- Leadership skills and personal development

Prerequisites:

- Must be current financial members of their respective club(s)
- Hold a proficient Bronze Medallion/Cert II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue) – proficient for 22/23 by 30 Nov
- Hold a current Provide First Aid certificate by 30 November
- Be a competent open-water swimmer and able to dive down to 3 metres
- Complete the required online coursework by 30 November
