# **EVENTS/PROGRAM**

# Round 1

# Port Elliott to Middleton (approximately 3.6km)

Backup plans are in place, so there will be racing in some format regardless of wind and swell predictions. Please make sure you bring helmets.

Staggered start, if necessary, with crews timed. Standard surf boat setup only. No rolling seats, no crew changes, and no boat modifications such as sprinklers.

7.30am - 8am – Boats to arrive and start being taken onto the beach.8.45am Sweeps briefing.9.00am start.

# Considering the current wind and swell forecasts, the backup venue may come into play. If so, it will be back to standard format racing so please be prepared.

Confirmation of venue and formats etc. will be out on all platforms on Thursday.

#### Rounds 2-3

These rounds will be standard surf boat racing format and any extra details will be made available on the SLSSA event calendar pages as they become available.

#### **SERIES AGE CATERGORIES**

- Open Men
- Open Women
- U23 Men
- U23 Women

The results will be based on accumulated point score across the series. Winners to be announced after the Robe carnival and prizes awarded.

#### WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there is a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

#### Lycra Hi-Vis Vests

The wearing of hi-visibility vests is compulsory for all competitors at this carnival.

#### **Entry Fees**

The carnival entry fee is set at **\$10 per entered competitor** for rounds 1-3 to be pooled for prize money at the end of the series. Please bring cash on the day or the club can advise to be invoiced.
