Surf Life Saving SA (SLSSA) is the peak organisation for water safety and lifesaving services in South Australia and is affiliated with Surf Life Saving Australia.

Surf Life Saving South Australia (SLSSA), with our partners, will deliver a river and inland water adaptation to "Beach" Nippers – called Rippers – to three regional communities (Murray Bridge, Renmark and Berri/Barmera). Rippers will provide local youth with active, healthy, and fun community-based activities, whilst building lifesaving and water safety knowledge and skills. The program sets young people on the path to becoming fully rounded participants in both lifesaving and sport.

To get started, in 2023, we will work with the Murray Bridge community to deliver a free Come and Try morning on Saturday November 25th. We will then work with the three regional communities to run 6–8-week programs in 2024.
