#### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

#### How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via SEMS (find SA 2023/24 Junior Carnival #2)

- Club officers tasked with entering competitors for carnivals will need permission for access to SEMS (if they
  don't already have this) which can be requested via <a href="http://support.sls.com.au">http://support.sls.com.au</a>

#### **Entry Closing Date**

Entries close on SEMS at 10am – Monday 11 December 2023.

Late entries will be accepted up until 10am on Thursday 14 December.

# **Entry Fees**

The Junior carnival entry fee is set at \$17.50 (GST exclusive) per entered competitor.

Any late entry (ie received after 10am, Monday 11 Dec and before 10am on Thursday 14 Dec) will be charged at \$60 (+ GST) per late entry competitor.

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the carnival.

There will be **no charge** for the original issue of RFID wristbands used for marshalling and recording of results. **A \$10 charge** will apply to replacement bands if required.

RFID wristband allocation will occur from 7:30am, all athletes who do not have one before the carnival please visit the admin tent on the lawn in front of the surf club before entering the beach.

• **Priority will be given too U12 & 13s** who have their first event at 8:15am, please ensure those families arrive at 7:30am to ensure the athletes are ready for their first event on time.

#### Eligibility

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries.

If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there is a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency. Please contact us if you have any queries re this.



# **ENTERING COMPETITORS INTO EVENTS IN SEMS – please follow this process:**

1. All INDIVIDUAL events will be a single division, and competitors will be spilt into graded/divisional races for additional rounds per event should time permit on the day. 1 hour maximum will be allocated per event before age groups will be asked to move to their next event/area.

# **Sporting Environment Policy**

Detailed information for Clubs to distribute to families will be forwarded ASAP.

Any person/s found to be non-compliant with our code of conduct requirements may be asked to leave and clubs may be penalised points that contribute to the Junior State Championship. If needed, SAPOL assistance will be sought.

#### **WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT**

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there be a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

# **CLUB REQUIREMENTS**

The Junior Carnival 2 Officials & Volunteer Roster is to be completed by Clubs by 12noon on Thurs 14 December. The link to the online form will be available on Calendar event on 5 December 2023.

#### **Photographers**

- Must have meet the requirements completed the <u>Accreditation Request Form</u> (once per photographer for the season) as per C23060 – Carnival Club Photographers 23-24
- The number of photographers per Club is limited to a maximum of 3 at any one time.
- A maximum of 1 x photographer per Club in any competition area also applies.
