WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there be a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via [SEMS](#) (find SA 2023/24 Junior Carnival #3)

- Club officers tasked with entering competitors for carnivals will need permission for access to SEMS (if they don't already have this) which can be requested via <http://support.sls.com.au>

Entry Closing Date

Entries close on SEMS at 12noon – Tuesday 16 January 2024.

Late entries will be accepted up until 12noon on Wednesday 17 January.

Entry Fees

The Junior carnival entry fee is set at **\$17.50 (GST exclusive) per entered competitor.**

Any late entry (ie received after 12noon, Tuesday 15 Jan and before 12noon on Wednesday 17 Jan) will be charged at \$60 (+ GST) per late entry competitor.

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the carnival.

There will be **no charge** for the original issue of RFID wristbands used for marshalling and recording of results.

A \$10 charge will apply to replacement bands if required.

RFID wristband allocation will occur from 7:30am, all athletes who do not have one before the carnival please visit the admin tent adjacent to the club before entering the beach.

Eligibility

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries.

Under 8 – Under 13	
SLSC Membership	Registered in Surfguard for 2023/24 Must hold competitive rights with the Club for which they are being entered to compete.
Award/s	Successfully have completed & recorded on Surfguard i. Junior Activities Preliminary Evaluation (<i>specific for their current age group</i>) AND, if wishing to participate in swim/board events/components: ii. Junior Activities Competition Skills evaluation (<i>specific for their current age group</i>)
Patrol Hours	Junior members do not undertake patrolling duties
Other	Must not be in default with their Club or SLSSA in relation to their service, financial or discipline obligations

If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there is a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency. Please contact us if you have any queries re this.

ENTERING COMPETITORS INTO EVENTS IN SEMS

All INDIVIDUAL events will be a single division. 1 hour maximum will be allocated per event before age groups will be asked to move to their next event/area.

INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

Sporting Environment Policy

CLUB REQUIREMENTS

The **Junior Carnival 3 Officials & Volunteer Roster** is to be completed by Clubs by 12noon on Thurs 18 January.

Officials

- Club allocations as per the [Officials & Volunteer Roster](#)
- Minimum requirements for new officials prior to the carnivals
 - Completed the Officials (Core or technical) online modules including ASC (Australian Sports commission- General officiating principles
 - Current WWCC recorded in surfguard. This must be entered by the club.

Photographers

- Must have meet the requirements completed the [Accreditation Request Form](#) (once per photographer for the season) as per [C23060 – Carnival Club Photographers 23-24](#)
- The number of photographers per Club is limited to a maximum of 3 at any one time.
- A maximum of 1 x photographer per Club in any competition area also applies.

IRB Water Cover

- The following clubs are rostered on to assist in the provision of IRB water safety:
 - South Port x2, Aldinga Bay x1, Seacliff x1
- To provide competent crew capable of setting cans with fully equipped IRB (incl radio)

Shallow Water Rescue personnel

- Competent, skilled surf swimmers (BM proficient) who would be called upon to assist should a shallow water rescue occur.
- List name/s of competent member/s who will be present at the carnival on the volunteer roster (as above)
