### WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

If, at any stage prior to or during competition, there is a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

### 1. Team Managers

- a. Please list your best contact to Officials & Volunteer roster and ensure they have requested to [join Senior Carnival Whatapp chat group](#) to receive any important updates regarding the carnival.

### 2. Officials

- a. Should wear either an officials shirt (if already have one from previous season) or alternatively sunsmart plain clothing (no club branding). Coloured vests will be available at admin for officials to put on over their clothing
- b. BYO sunsmart hat, water bottle (water will be available in the area to FILL your own drink bottle), sunscreen, clipboard, small notepad & pen/pencil
- c. Officials need to sign in at Admin on arrival.
- d. Morning Team & Lunch will be provided.

### 3. IRB Water Cover

- a. Thank you to the following Clubs for their assistance in the provision of IRB water safety:
  - i. Glenelg x1, Seacliff x1 & Goolwa x1
- b. To provide competent crew capable of setting cans with fully equipped IRB (incl radio)
- c. BYO water bottle & food
- d. Morning Tea & Lunch will be provided.

### 4. Under 14 competitors

- Clubs with Under 14 competitors who have NOT yet completed their Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) are to provide **COMPETENT** water safety personnel (WSP) with their own Rescue Board in the ratio of 1 WSP: 5 competitors.
- Clubs must provide the details to the area referee of those competitors who do not have their SRC at marshalling.

### 5. Shallow Water Rescue personnel

- a. Competent, skilled surf swimmers (BM proficient) who would be called upon to assist should a shallow water rescue occur
- b. List name/s of competent member/s who will be present at the carnival on the volunteer roster (as above)
- c. Will be called for briefing at start of the day

### 6. Photographer/s

- a. Please indicate name of Club Photographer/s on the Club team management list. However they also

- need to be showing in Liveheats are approved (Photographers event)
- b. Must have meet the requirements completed the Accreditation Request Form (once per photographer for the season) as per [C23060 – Carnival Club Photographers 23-24](#)
