Note:

- Extra time has been allocated to Div 1 Flags on Day 2 as qualifying rounds were not completed on Day 1, with the final draw will be revised and published on LiveHeats no later than Thursday 14 March.
- All-age Taplin has been removed from the Day 3 program due to time restraints.
- U8 Board Relay has been added to the program for Day 3.
- March Past has been moved to first event on Day 3, due tide heights/beach availability in the morning of Day 2, which has allowed for all individual events to start earlier at 8:30am.

Note: Results from U13 Champion Lifesaver, U11 R&R + U13 R&R event being conducted at the Surf Rescue State Championships will also contribute to the Junior State Championship – Champion Club.



EVENT FORMAT

- All water events + all team events
 - Heats/finals format within the divisions (div 1 & div 2)
- Beach Sprints
 - \circ 1st round to be random draw no division allocations.
 - \circ Top 4 from the 1st round to progress to the next div 1 round and continue in division 1.
 - Remaining competitors to be allocated into division 2 after the 1st round of sprints.
 - Division 2 to continue to medals; Division 1 to continue qualifying till semi-final on Day 1
- Beach Flags
 - o 1st round to be random draw no division allocations.
 - 1st round to end once a total of 24 competitors are eliminated.
 - The 24 competitors eliminated will compete together in division 2.
 - Remaining competitors not eliminated will continue to progress as Division 1 competitors.
 - Division 2 to continue to medals; Division 1 to continue qualifying till semi-final on Day 1

COMPOSITE TEAMS

- Clubs are required to label such teams in SEMS as 'COMPOSITE' for easy identification
- Composite teams are to be entered into Division 2
- The priority will be to form the team from the composites available between clubs that don't have any teams entered div 1 or 2 of that event. Once those competitors have been allocated all remaining athletes will be formed as composite teams regardless how many teams a club has entered.
- Only the Marshal will be able to complete composite team in LIVEHEATS.

TEAM CHANGES

Team changes are to be made via LIVEHEATS. Changes can be made as soon as the event becomes available on Liveheats an up to the event being marshalled. Team Changes WILL NOT be accepted by the Marshal in the competition areas. Team Managers/Age Group Managers are responsible for their competitors knowing which team they are in. Any team found to have incorrect names during or after the event may be disqualified. Only Composite teams will be managed be the Mashal.

WATER SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT

The Safety & Emergency Committee will meet prior to the start of the carnival to determine any final procedures regarding water safety and risk management.

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there be a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Safety & Emergency Committee and/or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Safety & Emergency Committee shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Competition and Safety and Emergency Committees will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.

Lycra Hi-Vis Vests

The wearing of hi-visibility vests is compulsory for all competitors in water events including run leg of Cameron relays. These can be either fluorescent pink, fluorescent yellow or fluorescent green. This requirement extends to craft handlers who must also wear Club competition cap.

SPORTING ENVIROMENT POLICY

Any person/s found to be non-compliant with our <u>sporting environment framework</u> or code of conduct requirements may be asked to leave and clubs may be penalised points that contribute to the <u>Junior State</u> <u>Championship – Champion Club</u>. If needed, SAPOL assistance will be sought.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via <u>SEMS</u> (find 2024 SA Junior State Championships – note Day 1 & Days 2/3 will be separate events)

Entry Fees

The event entry fee is set at \$60 (+ GST) per entered competitor. Please note that the entry fee covers ALL of the state championship events for Under 8 – Under 13s including Champion lifesaver & R&R conducted at Surf Rescue State Championships.

Any late entry (ie received after close of normal entries and before close of late entries) will be charged at \$100 (+ GST) per late entry competitor.

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the championships.



Eligibility

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries.

Junior Activities Competition Skills Evaluation (specific for their age group)
Patrol Hours	Junior members do not undertake patrolling obligations
Other	Must not be in default with their Club or SLSSA in relation to their service, financial or discipline obligations

If a member is not showing as eligible in SEMS then there be a problem with either their registration, membership category/competition rights and/or award proficiency.

ENTERING COMPETITORS INTO DIVISONS & SEMS – AGMs/Team Managers please follow this process

- 1. Please refer to <u>Liveheats Rankings</u> above the cut line must be entered into division 1 for that event. *Note:*
 - a. Clubs are welcome to add competitors into Div 1 if they believe that this appropriate.
 - b. Clubs are able apply discretion on which division a competitor is entered for individual events that are not listed in the rankings due to not able to compete at one of the individual carnivals.
- Teams must enter a minimum number of division 1 teams as per the 2024 State Championship- Division 1 Team Events Minimum document. This will be made available on the <u>event calendar page</u> by Friday 16 February 2024. These allocations have been made based on individual ranking results.
- 3. Competitors must only be entered into max. ONE division for any event (even though SEMS will show their name for both)
- 4. Composite teams (ONLY enter in Division 2) please change name of team to COMPOSITE

CLUB & VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

The Junior State Championships <u>Officials & Volunteer Roster</u> is to be completed by Clubs by 12noon on the Wednesday prior to each weekend. The following roles are to be filled by Clubs & details provided in the above Roster.

• Rosters for each weekend will be available via once available

Pre-Carnival BRIEFINGS will occur Thursday at 7.30pm before each weekend via Zoom

Clubs to have a minimum 1 x rep per + Referee & Area Referees

1. Team Manager

- a. Attend any team manager briefing during the event
- b. Model & promote good sporting behaviour
- c. Are to attend the **Pre-Carnival BRIEFING on Thursday prior to each weekend at 7.30pm via Zoom** <u>https://us02web.zoom.us/j/8623722908</u>



2. Water Safety Personnel

- a. Clubs will be rostered based on 2023/24 carnival entry numbers.
- b. Must be proficient SRC or BM members (no more than 50% can be SRC only)
- c. Are to wear SURF RESCUE uniform & have rescue board or tube with them
- d. Allocated to specific water area/s according to the volunteer roster
- e. Are to report to Central Admin 30 mins prior to area start time to sign in

3. IRB Water Cover

- a. The rostered clubs for State Championships are:
 - a. Day 1 = Seacliff (x2); Brighton; Somerton
 - b.Day 2 = Port Noarlunga (x2); Brighton; Grange
 - c. Day 3 = Port Noarlunga (x2); Somerton; Henley
- b. SLSSA will make payment of \$240+gst per IRB to the relevant club/s after the event
- c. Refer <u>Circular</u> for full details

4. Shallow Water Rescue personnel

- a. Competent, skilled surf swimmer (1 x BM proficient per rostered Club) who would be called upon to assist should a shallow water rescue occur.
- b. Such persons will be called for a briefing at start of their session.
- c. They are not required to wear patrol uniform but should have bathers etc under clothing should they be required to act.

5. Officials

- a. Must be accredited or currently in training
- b. Should be competent for the role/s they will be undertaking
- c. Be available for the full day that specific role/area or age group is completing for
- d. To wear comfortable, sun safe clothing (non-Club branded). Officials vests are provided on the day
- e. Lunch and snacks will be provided relative to the duration of their volunteering; BYO water bottle (water dispensers available for refilling)

6. Photographer/s

- a. Must sign on and off at the admin tent.
- b. Must have meet the requirements completed the <u>Accreditation Request Form</u> (once per photographer for the season) as per <u>C23060 Carnival Club Photographers 23-24</u>
- c. The number of photographers per Club is limited to a maximum of 3 at any one time.
- d. A maximum of 1 x photographer per Club in any competition area also applies.
