Miami Beach, Queensland

The event is an open interstate competition (total approx. 18 athletes in the team, 9 male & 9 female).

Athlete Selection

In accordance with the SLSSA State & Representative Teams Criteria, selection for the SA team will be based on:

- Results from the SLSSA Carnivals 2024
- Team balance and composition
- SLSSA Trials may also be conducted and considered if necessary.
- Results from 2023 SLSSA Carnivals & State Championships may be consider if necessary

It is anticipated that the athletes will be informed on the week commencing 17th June 2024.

Team Leader Requirements

- Be a minimum age of 18 years; hold a current Working with Children Check (or be willing to undertake)
- Understanding the delivery of a high performance environment & outcomes
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically
- Have comprehensive knowledge & experience of IRB Racing competitions and rules
- Ability to supervise and provide duty of care for a large group including children
- Demonstrate the ability to assist athletes' preparation & performance

It is anticipated that the Team Leaders will be announced in the week commencing 29th April 2024.

Team Trainings

Training to be advised once the team is selected.

Travel Logistics

Athletes selected in the SA IRB Racing State Team will be required to arrange & cover their own costs associated with travelling as a member of the team. Selected members under 18 will need to have a parent or designated guardian assigned. Team uniform will be provided at NO COST to all selected athletes.
