Note: Masters individual & line throw events will be conducted in 4 age categories 30-40, 40-50, 50-59 and 60+ Masters Line throw team age is based on the age of the youngest competitor.

#### **INDIVIDUAL EVENTS**

NOTE: in line with Australian Pool Rescue Championships and due to time constraints competitors must compete in their specific age category ONLY and are not eligible to compete in any other age individual events except instances where their age group is not offered in an event (ie masters competitors are able to contest Open Super Lifesaver, Rescue Medley & 200m Obstacles). Any Masters wishing to be entered into these events must be emailed to Surf.Sport@surlfifesavingsa.com.au

To provide a higher quality racing opportunity for competitors and program efficiency we are planning to have all competitors entered into their respective age groups, however on race day they will all swim in the one combined event, with points & medals being split into the respective age groups as we previously done at the State Pool Rescue Championships.

#### **TEAM EVENTS**

SLSSA policy allows for Under 15 competitors WITH a proficient Bronze Medallion to compete up in U17, Open or U17-Open TEAM EVENTS only whilst still adhering to maximum of two age groups for any one team event.

U11-U14 Athletes Competitors can step up age groups to make up a team but cannot represent 100% of the members in that team must be at least 1 competitor from the correct age group. For example, an U12 Team cannot have 2x U11s competitors.



#### **COMPOSITE TEAMS**

Composite team requests are to be entered into SEMS during entries. Teams are to be formed prior to marshalling and should be submitted to the surf sports team or admin by the following times,

- Friday Team Events by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July, 5pm
- Sunday Team Events by Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July, 8am

Composite teams that podium, will be awarded a "duplicate" medal (along with the full club team), but no championship points will be awarded to the clubs represented in that composite team (points will be awarded to the full club team in that position).

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP POINT SCORE**

Championship points will be awarded as follows:

- 1st 5 points
- 2nd 3 points
- 3rd 1 point

#### **OVERALL CHAMPION CLUB**

The 2024 Pool Rescue results will count towards the 2024/24 Overall Champion Club pennant to be presented in March 2025.

#### **OFFICIALS & VOLUNTEERS**

To be eligible to compete, clubs will be rostered based on participation numbers from 2023 season. Please refer to <a href="Officials & Volunteer Roster">Officials & Volunteer Roster</a> for appointments & allocations. **The following roles do not require an accredited official**:

- Equipment setters
- Timekeepers

## **EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS**

- SLSSA will supply the Rescue Tubes, Manikins, Bricks and Lines for the use of competitors during competition. Such equipment will comply with the ILS/SLSA specifications.
- All competitors are required to supply their own fins (for specifications for compliance please refer SLSA Surf Sports Manual):
  - o Rubber fins for U12/13 athletes
  - o Fibreglass or Rubber fins for U14 masters athletes
- All competition equipment may be subject to scrutineering checks during the event
- Club caps (or swim caps) <u>must</u> be worn and all must be <u>consistent</u> in team events (excluding composite teams).

#### **POOL DECK ACCESS**

Spectators will NOT be allowed on pool deck. Only Competitors, Officials and volunteer positions are permitted.

## **FIRST AID & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

SA Aquatic & Leisure Centre staff will be responsible for any emergency management or first aid required to attendees.

Final Information to be communicated with Team Managers, Junior Contacts & Surf Sport Officers prior to the event.



#### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

#### How to enter competitors

Entries must be submitted via <u>SEMS</u> by no later than 10am on Wednesday 26 June 2024 (late entries close 10am, Mon 1 July). A guide to entering entries via SEMS can be found <u>here on our website</u>

As we have to transfer all of our nominations to the appropriate IT program for use at the pool,

PLEASE ONLY ENTER PEOPLE INTO EVENTS THAT THEY WILL COMPETE IN.

This is also critical as competitors will be allocated a lane and 'no shows' can cause considerable inconvenience.

If requesting a composite team, please adjust team name to **composite** in SEMS.

## **Entry Fees**

The event entry fee is set at \$60 (+ GST) per entered competitor.

Late entry fees are charged for any entries made after 10am on Tuesday 25/6/24 and before close of late entries (10am, Monday 1 July 2024). This fee is set at the entry fee + 100% of entry fee (ie total \$100 + GST). Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the championships.
