




Race Results

To check results of a particular event you selection the event under the divisions this will show all the heats/rounds for the event and progression into the final etc.


- You can also check result of a particular heat by clicking on the in the schedule.
- You can also check who has made the final by click that final in the schedule.
- DQ in any particular race will show as rank "20"
- DNS in any particular race will show as rank "30"





Round Results

If you click on round leaderboard it will show the rankings after the 2 rounds of racing. Lowest points will be ranked 1st.





Combined Event Results

For Events that have combined events the round leaderboard will show inclusive results from all events, however when you click on the Result tab you have the choice to select/filter for particular event from the drop down box.



IRB Premiership Round Results

The Club leaderboard / Premiership points for each carnival will be made available on the <u>liveheats event page</u> after the carnival is completed in most cases this might not show till the next day.

Points will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd (5,3,1) for each event conducted at all carnivals and state championships. Events that conduct a final, the points will be awarded based on the race result of the final. For all other events that only conduct rounds, an accumulation of points achieved from all rounds conducted will determine the placings for that event at the specific carnival.



OFFICIALS, COMMITTEES & VOLUNTEERS

Officials Quota

Each competing club is required to supply a minimum of 2 x officials for the duration of each carnival. However, if clubs have more, please provide them where possible. Officials should not be competing or handling on the day.

Carnival Workparty Volunteers

Workparty is to be provided by the competing clubs & as such, each club is to provide:

- 2 x workparty volunteers from 2 hours prior to carnival start time (ie 7am for most) until set up
- 2 x workparty volunteers from finish of racing until packed up

It is up to each club as to how they prefer to manage their volunteer roster for this.

Contingency Plan

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there is a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Carnival Safety Committee and / or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Carnival Safety Committee and / or appropriate officials shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition. Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Carnival Committees and / or appropriate officials will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.
