Environment:

Surf Life Saving SA (SLSSA) is the peak organisation for surf lifesaving in South Australia and is affiliated with Surf Life Saving Australia.

Surf Life Saving SA is responsible for the governance, development, promotion and administration of surf lifesaving throughout South Australia and has the responsibility for servicing its 9,000 members and 22 clubs.

- Represent SA on national committees, panels and matters as/when required and ensure information is communicated to and from panel and SSAC

IRB Racing Panel

To lead the IRB Racing Panel to achieve the following:

- To disseminate Surf Sports rules, regulation and conditions of competition as laid down in Surf Life Saving Australia's Surf Sports Manual, Circulars and Bulletins and promote best practice IRB racing activities
- To monitor and make recommendations on all IRB racing related activities, and the like in South Australia

- To assist SA clubs to develop their IRB racing participation through facilitation of competition and coaching development activities and programs
- To develop IRB racing plans, activities and events and innovate to provide world leading IRB racing opportunities.
- Represent, to the best of their ability, the IRB racing needs of the membership, addressing challenges and identifying solutions as appropriate.
- Facilitate learning, development and feedback opportunities amongst the state IRB racing community utilising appropriate media/methodology
- Review, develop and maintain the relevant IRB racing programs, events, rules and policies
- Collaboratively engage internal & external stakeholders to formulate a development and high performance pathways framework to help SLSSA members achieve their sporting goals
