## What you will require...

## You will need the following Items:

- Proof of Purchase / Ownership (invoice showing no balance owing - i.e., \$0.00),
- Original copy of your Boat Code Certificate,
- Your surf club client number (from your Club Registrar, Gear \& Equipment officer or Powercraft Captain / Officer),
- Surf Life Saving South Australia (SLSSA) registration number from the Lifesaving Team at Surf Central (lifesaving@surfligesavingsa.com.au),
- A way to make payment (cash or credit card),
- The following forms, which can be found online at https://service.sa.gov.au/ or at your nearest Service SA branch:
- Application for Initial Registration of a Motorboat (MR168)
- Application for Exemption from Payment of Registration Fees (MR149)
- Application for a Change of Registration Number (MR153).


## Registering your new IRB

## Step by Step process

## Step 1

Complete all three (3) forms as follows:

- 'Application for Initial Registration of a Motorboat' (Form MR168) - refer to Enclosure 1,
- 'Application for Exemption from Payment of Registration Fees' (Form MR149) - refer to Enclosure 2, and
- 'Application for a Change of Registration Number' (Form MR153) forms (refer to Enclosure $3)$.
- When completing Form MR153, contact the Lifesaving Team at Surf Central to obtain the next available SL registration number. Insert the SL assigned number into Section 2 of the Form.
- If you do not obtain a SL registration number, Service SA will give you a generic boat registration number and you will not be eligible for the exemption.

Step 2
Take the completed application forms (Forms MR149, MR153 \& MR168), and Proof of Purchase / Ownership, and the original copy of the Boat Code Certificate to your nearest Service SA Branch.

Step 3
Update Surfguard with your new IRB registration details.

## Deregistering your IRB

## Step by step process

## Step 1

Contacts SLSSA (lifesaving@surfligesavingsa.com.au) to request that the IRB is deregistered prior to sale / disposal.

## Step 2

SLSSA will complete 'Application for a Cancellation of Motor Boat Registration' (Form MR180) and take to Service SA Branch.

As there is no fee associated with IRB registration your Club will not receive any money for remaining registration.

Step 3

The Lifesaving Team will forward the new registration details to your Club Point of Contact (POC) prior to sale / disposal of your IRB.

Note: The SLSSA number is now free to be reallocated.

## Step 4

Amend your club IRB details in Surfguard to reflect that it is no longer available.

## Transferring IRB registration

## Step by Step process

## Step 1

Complete an 'Application for a Change of Registration Number' (Form MR153).

## Step 2

Take the completed 'Application for a Change of Registration Number' (Form MR153) form to Service SA Branch..

Service SA will then remove the SLSSA registration and give the boat a general boat registration number.

## Step 3

Wait for the new Certificate of Motor Boat Registration to arrive in the mail. This will show the new general registration number.

Get the new owner to fill out both parts located at the rear of the form. The new owner will then take and lodge the bottom part of the form and the surf club will lodge the top part. This must be done within 14 days of sale.

Make sure the new owner has the original - or a copy of - the Boat Code Certificate so they can register the boat in their name.

## Step 4

Update your club details in Surfguard.
Advise the Lifesaving Team that you have transferred the registration to a private owner and that the SL number is now free.

## Things to know

## Want a replacement registration label?

Complete an 'Application for a Replacement Number Plate' (Form MR150).

This form can be found online at https://service.sa.gov.au/ or at your nearest Service SA Branch.

Take the completed form to Service SA.

There is a fee associated with being issued a replacement label.

## Selling your IRB?

You will need to provide the new owner with a receipt of payment as they are required to have a Proof of Ownership document for Service SA.

You will need to provide the new owner a copy (or the original) Boat Code Certificate as this is required by Service SA from the new owner.

Do not transfer your IRB directly to the new owner as they will take the SLSSA registration.

## READ THIS FIRST

1. This form is for the registration of a recreational vessel fitted with an engine that has not been previously registered in South Australia.
2. Vessels to be registered must be in the name of a 'Natural Person' or 'Body Corporate'.
3. $\widetilde{\text { BOAT }}$ A Hull Identification Number (HIN) must be affixed to your vessel by a Boat Code Agent to complete the registration. If your vessel does not BOAT have a HIN, a temporary registration certificate valid for 21 days will be issued. An information leaflet on Boat Code requirements and a list of authorised Boat Code Agents are available from any Service SA Customer Service Centre.
4. Please use 'BLOCK' letters and complete the relevant sections.
5. The new owner of a vessel must provide Proof of Ownership. This may be a signed and dated statement from the previous owner; Recreational Registration Certificate in your name issued in another State; Commercial Vessel Registration Certificate in your name; or Statutory Declaration signed by a Justice of the Peace.
6. If you wish to be allocated a special club number an Application for a Change of Registration Number (MR153) must be lodged with this application.
7. If you wish, the vessel can be registered in joint names but full details must be supplied for each registration holder. A vessel cannot be registered to a person who is less than 16 years old.
8. Each registration holder must provide Evidence of Identity and, for a person, Evidence of Age. Refer to the Evidence of Identity leaflet (MR 583) available at Service SA Customer Service Centres or www.service.sa.gov.au
9. Payment - Cheque or money order should be made payable to "Department for Infrastructure and Transport" and marked "Not Negotiable". Credit card payment by MasterCard or Visa is also accepted at Service SA Customer Service Centres.
10. The information provided may be used to update records relating to you under the Motor Vehicles Act 1959.
11.
